

## 2023 FISCAL YEAR END REPORT

Chapters 778 and 779 of the 2016 Virginia Acts of Assembly amended Title 2.2 of the Code of Virginia by adding Chapter 24 to create the Virginia Growth and Opportunity Board (the Board) and the Virginia Growth and Opportunity Fund (VGOF) within the Virginia Growth and Opportunity Act. Chapter 1 Item 115 Section N.6.b requires the Department to submit a report of outcomes associated with closed projects that received a grant from the Virginia Growth and Opportunity Fund at the close of each fiscal year. The information provided here an overview of Board funded projects that were closed between July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.

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### 2 THE FUND

Appropriations for the Virginia Growth and Opportunity Fund are included in the budget for the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD). The fund, as created in §2.2-2487 of the Code, has three grant categories:

- (1) Capacity building funds to assist regional councils in building capacity for job creation and program implementation (capacity building grants);
- (2) Per capita project grants allocated to each region on a per capita basis for projects of regional significance (per capita grants); and
- (3) Competitive grants awarded for projects of statewide economic impact and interregional collaborations (competitive grants).

The FY23-FY24 biennium budget allocated \$30.0 million for the fund in FY23. The following chart shows the distribution for FY23 among the three fund categories, including the per capita allocation across nine GO Virginia regions.

## 3 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Department of Housing and Community Development continued its support of Growth and Opportunity Virginia Board funded projects in **four priority investment strategies; startup ecosystems**, **cluster scale-up**, **workforce development**, **and site development and infrastructure**. These strategies are recognized as essential building blocks for sustaining and accelerating the growth of traded industry clusters, which are interrelated firms who together contribute significantly to Virginia's total economic output. Firms in supported traded clusters are positioned to compete to serve national and international markets and most importantly, drive wealth-creating employment opportunities for Virginians.

Among closed projects, there is an important distinction to be made in relation to regional per capita projects. These projects fall into one of two different categories: (a) implementation projects and (b) planning, pilot, and feasibility studies.

All implementation projects include quantified outcomes that are submitted as part of the initial application, included in the contracts obligating funds, and ultimately tracked and reported throughout the contract lifespan and in the final performance closeout report. While in recent years these outcome metrics have been solidified and the process for metric tracking from contractual obligation through closeout has become a focus of the program, at the earliest onset of the program, those processes weren't in place. In those cases, many of the outcomes reported by the end of reporting were not gathered during the application period, and therefore appear as "not measured" in this report. There are other instances where more recent projects have committed outcomes as well as outcomes that appear as "not measured" due to those outcomes not being contractually obligated but still tracked by the grantee and subgrantee.

Planning, pilot, and feasibility studies often do not have quantified contractual outcomes and appear in this report as "not applicable". These projects, which are limited to less than \$100,000 per project and may make up no more than \$250,000 worth of projects by region each fiscal year, are developed and submitted with quantitative outcomes, usually in the form of a study or report. All projects falling under this category are required to demonstrate in the application process that they are precursor to a future implementation project through the GO Virginia

program. An example of this relationship is demonstrated through the SHD Sites ECB, which closed this fiscal year, but led to a more than \$800,000 implementation project that is currently in the implementation phase and will likely appear in a future closeout report.

All outcomes resulting from the Growth and Opportunity Virginia Program are self-reported with signed attestations to the accuracy of results reported submitted with closeout reports by both the subgrantee and the respective Regional Council Chair.

#### **Investment Strategy Outcomes**

#### Site Development and Infrastructure

Of the GO Virginia projects closed in fiscal year 2023, there were seven site development and infrastructure planning projects and two site development and infrastructure implementation projects. The following are achieved outcome metrics for the implementation projects: 14,100 linear feet of sewer line completed, 33,100 linear feet of water line completed, 20,000 feet of linear gas line completed, 1,725 acres advanced per the VEDP Virginia Business Ready Sites Program Scale, and 1,600 total acres developed.

#### **Workforce Development**

Of the GO Virginia projects closed in fiscal year 2023, there were six workforce development planning projects and eighteen workforce development implementation projects. The following are achieved outcome metrics for the implementation projects: 5,738 students trained, 3,214 credentials awarded, 17 students enrolled in dual enrollment, 689 internships created, 16 new programs implemented, 17,666 jobs created/filled, 1,032 employees upskilled, 48 existing jobs retained, and 4,029 businesses served.

#### **Startup Ecosystems**

Of the GO Virginia projects closed in fiscal year 2023, there were five startup ecosystem planning projects and eight startup ecosystem implementation projects. The following are achieved outcome metrics for the implementation projects: 11,019 businesses served, 47 businesses created, 33 existing businesses expanded, 309 entrepreneurs engaged, \$26,896,662 of capital deployed, \$18,790,250 of capital raised, \$131,065 average deal size,

149 fund investments, 18 new programs implemented, 4,065 students trained, 7,478 jobs created/filled, 10,445 existing jobs retained, 25 internships created, and 4 apprenticeships created.

#### Cluster Scale-Up

Of the GO Virginia projects closed in fiscal year 2023, there were six cluster scale-up planning projects and six cluster scale-up implementation projects. The following are achieved outcome metrics for the implementation projects: 9 businesses attracted, 468 jobs created/filled, 36 internships created, 807 businesses served, 16 businesses retained, 6 existing businesses expanded, 5 new products released to market, and \$4,000,000 of capital raised.
