I am writing to report on the Virginia Investment Performance (VIP) and Major Eligible Employer (MEE) grants that were awarded during the second quarter of the 2024 calendar year as required by § 2.2-5103(D) of the <u>Code of Virginia</u>.

In the second quarter, ending June 30, 2024, no VIP grants were awarded. Additionally, no MEE grants were awarded in the second quarter of 2024.

Virginia Investment Performance:

No VIP grants were awarded.

Major Eligible Employer:

No MEE grants were awarded.

For the second quarter of the 2024 calendar year, disbursements from the VIP were made to Hollister, Abbott, Dominion Packaging, Canon, and WhiteWave Foods.

No VIP grants were awarded during this quarter because the existing legislative cap has been met. However, Chapters 563 and 624 of the 2024 Acts of Assembly reauthorized the grant, and additional grants may be offered after July 1, 2024.
