SUBJECT: Transfer & Treatment of Sexual Assault Survivors by Virginia Hospitals

This report is submitted in compliance with subsection B of the Code of Virginia § 32.1-162.15:7, which states:

*The Department shall report to the Governor and the General Assembly by December 1 of each year on:*

- 1. The name of each hospital that has submitted a sexual assault survivor treatment plan, sexual assault survivor transfer plan, or pediatric sexual assault survivor transfer plan in accordance with the requirements of this section and, for each hospital, the specific type of plan, the date on which the plan was submitted, and the date on which the plan was approved;*
- 2. The name of each hospital that has failed to submit a sexual assault survivor treatment plan, sexual assault survivor transfer plan, or pediatric sexual assault survivor transfer plan in accordance with the requirements of this section;*

3. *The name of each hospital for which an inspection was performed pursuant to subsection A and for each such hospital, the date of such inspection, and whether the hospital was found to be in compliance with the provisions of the sexual assault survivor treatment plan, sexual assault survivor transfer plan, or pediatric sexual assault survivor transfer plan for such hospital approved by the Department; and*
4. *For each hospital determined to be out of compliance with the requirements of the sexual assault survivor treatment plan, sexual assault survivor transfer plan, or pediatric sexual assault survivor transfer plan for such hospital approved by the Department, whether a plan of correction was submitted in accordance with the provisions of subsection A.*

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

---

The Virginia Department of Health (VDH) is submitting this report in response to the legislative mandated in subsection B of Code of Virginia § 32.1-162.15:7, which requires VDH to annually submit to the Governor and General Assembly information regarding hospital compliance with the requirements of Article 8 (§ 32.1-162.15:2 *et seq.*) of Chapter 5 of Title 32.1 of the Code of Virginia. This includes data regarding submission to VDH of proposed hospital plans for the transfer and treatment of adult and pediatric sexual assault survivors and hospital inspections related to compliance with approved plans. This report is due by December 1 of each year.

From July 1, 2023<sup>1</sup> to present:

1. Thirty-two hospitals submitted and received approval for adult sexual assault survivor (SAS) transfer plans.
  - a. An additional two hospitals submitted SAS transfer plans for VDH's approval, for which VDH has not yet concluded its review.<sup>2</sup>
  - b. An additional eight hospitals submitted SAS transfer plans that were denied VDH's approval, and have not re-submitted their plans, with appropriate revisions, for VDH's review.
  - c. One hospital submitted and received approval for a SAS transfer plan for its freestanding emergency department but did not submit a plan for the entirety of the hospital.
2. Twenty-nine hospitals submitted and received approval for pediatric sexual assault survivor (PSAS) transfer plans.
  - a. An additional two hospitals submitted PSAS transfer plans for VDH's approval, for which VDH has not yet concluded its review.
  - b. An additional five hospitals submitted PSAS transfer plans that were denied VDH's approval, and have not re-submitted their plans, with appropriate revisions, for VDH's review.
  - c. One hospital submitted and received approval for a PSAS transfer plan for its freestanding emergency department but did not submit a plan for the entirety of the hospital.
3. Fifteen hospitals submitted and received approval for SAS treatment plans.
  - a. An additional four hospitals submitted SAS treatment plans for VDH's approval, for which VDH has not yet concluded its review.
  - b. An additional seven hospitals submitted SAS treatment plans that were denied VDH's approval, and have not re-submitted their plans, with appropriate revisions, for VDH's review.
4. Eighteen hospitals submitted and received approval for PSAS treatment plans.

- a. An additional 4 hospitals submitted PSAS treatment plans for VDH's approval, for which VDH has not yet concluded its review.
  - b. An additional hospital submitted a PSAS treatment plan that was denied VDH's approval, and has not re-submitted their plans, with appropriate revisions, for VDH's review.
5. One hundred twelve hospitals were noncompliant with the plan submission requirements in that they failed to submit any plan for VDH's review and approval.
- a. One hospital submitted and received approval for a SAS transfer plan and a PSAS transfer plan for its freestanding emergency department but did not submit a plan for the entirety of the hospital.
6. Zero hospitals were inspected for compliance with the requirements of Article 8 (§ 32.1-162.15:2 *et seq.*) of Chapter 5 of Title 32.1 of the Code of Virginia and their approved plan.

## INTRODUCTION

---

### REPORT MANDATE

Subsection B of § 32.1-162.15:7 of the Code of Virginia (Appendix A) requires the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) to annually submit to the Governor and General Assembly by December 1:

1. The name of each hospital that has submitted a sexual assault survivor treatment plan, sexual assault survivor transfer plan, or pediatric sexual assault survivor transfer plan in accordance with the requirements of this section and, for each hospital, the specific type of plan, the date on which the plan was submitted, and the date on which the plan was approved;
2. The name of each hospital that has failed to submit a sexual assault survivor treatment plan, sexual assault survivor transfer plan, or pediatric sexual assault survivor transfer plan in accordance with the requirements of [§ 32.1-162.15:7 of the Code of Virginia];
3. The name of each hospital for which an inspection was performed pursuant to subsection A [of § 32.1-162.15:7 of the Code of Virginia] and for each such hospital, the date of such inspection, and whether the hospital was found to be in compliance with the provisions of the sexual assault survivor treatment plan, sexual assault survivor transfer plan, or pediatric sexual assault survivor transfer plan for such hospital approved by [VDH]; and
4. For each hospital determined to be out of compliance with the requirements of the sexual assault survivor treatment plan, sexual assault survivor transfer plan, or pediatric sexual assault survivor transfer plan for such hospital approved by [VDH], whether a plan of correction was submitted in accordance with the provisions of subsection A [of § 32.1-162.15:7 of the Code of Virginia].

### REPORT OUTLINE

Following the discussion of the report mandate, the report provides listings of which hospitals have submitted a plan for VDH's review and the outcome of those plan reviews. The report then lists which hospitals have not submitted a plan for VDH's consideration or have not submitted a plan that the entirety of the hospital. The report concludes with a summary of inspection activities for the enforcement of these requirements, dating from July 1, 2023 to the date of this report.<sup>3</sup>

APPENDIX A – CODE OF VIRGINIA § 32.1-162.15:7

---

**§ 32.1-162.15:7. Inspections; report required.**

- A. The Department shall periodically conduct such inspections of hospitals licensed by the Department as may be necessary to ensure that sexual assault survivor treatment plans, sexual assault survivor transfer plans, and pediatric sexual assault survivor transfer plans are implemented in accordance with the requirements of this article.
  
- B. The Department shall report to the Governor and the General Assembly by December 1 of each year on:
  - 1. The name of each hospital that has submitted a sexual assault survivor treatment plan, sexual assault survivor transfer plan, or pediatric sexual assault survivor transfer plan in accordance with the requirements of this section and, for each hospital, the specific type of plan, the date on which the plan was submitted, and the date on which the plan was approved;
  
  - 2. The name of each hospital that has failed to submit a sexual assault survivor treatment plan, sexual assault survivor transfer plan, or pediatric sexual assault survivor transfer plan in accordance with the requirements of this section;
  
  - 3. The name of each hospital for which an inspection was performed pursuant to subsection A and for each such hospital, the date of such inspection, and whether the hospital was found to be in compliance with the provisions of the sexual assault survivor treatment plan, sexual assault survivor transfer plan, or pediatric sexual assault survivor transfer plan for such hospital approved by the Department; and
  
  - 4. For each hospital determined to be out of compliance with the requirements of the sexual assault survivor treatment plan, sexual assault survivor transfer plan, or pediatric sexual assault survivor transfer plan for such hospital approved by the Department, whether a plan of correction was submitted in accordance with the provisions of subsection A.
