During the first quarter of fiscal year 2025, 2,669 requests for waivers of statutory fee caps were submitted seeking a total of \$ 1,722,464 and 2,613 requests for waivers were approved for a total of \$ 1,656,028 paid to court-appointed attorneys above the initial statutory fee cap.
