Chapter 551, Enactment Clause 24, of the Virginia Acts of Assembly (Special ession I, 2021) requires the Office of the Executive Secretary of the Supreme Court of Virginia to report to the Chairs of the Senate Committee on the Judiciary, the Senate Committee on Finance and Appropriations, the House Committee on Appropriations, and the House Committee for Courts of Justice by November 1 of each year regarding the number of civil offenses committed and civil penalties imposed for violations of §§ 4.1-1100, 4.1-1105, and 4.1-1105.1 of the Code of Virginia.

The following civil offenses were committed¹ and civil penalties imposed² for the period of October 20, 2023, through October 1, 2024:
