I am writing to report on the Virginia Investment Performance (VIP) and Major Eligible Employer (MEE) grants that were awarded during the fourth quarter of the 2024 calendar year as required by § 2.2-5103(D) of the Code of Virginia.

In the fourth quarter, ending December 31, 2024, two VIP grants were awarded. No MEE grants were awarded in the fourth quarter of 2024.

Virginia Investment Performance:

- 1. **Shamrock Foods**, located in Augusta County, is a manufacturer of dairy products. Awarded a \$600,000 grant, the company will be making a \$59.0 million investment and creating 28 new jobs by December 31, 2028. This project has been announced.
