Report on Number of Individuals Practicing under Temporary Authorization to Practice Without Subsequently Receiving Full Licensure

Virginia Department of Health Professions

July 1, 2025

Virginia Code § 54.1-2408.4(D) states the following:

The Department of Health Professions shall, beginning July 1, 2023, annually report to the Chairmen of the Senate Committee on Education and Health and the House Committee on [Health and Human Services] the number of out-of-state health care practitioners who have utilized the temporary authorization to practice pending licensure and have not subsequently been issued full licensure.

Pursuant to that directive, the Virginia Department of Health Professions ("DHP") reports the following numbers of individuals that have not been issued full licensure¹ following temporary authorization to practice pursuant to Virginia Code § 54.1-2408.4 for the preceding year:
