Subject: Annual Report on the Utilization of the Department of Corrections, Capital Infrastructure Fund (CIF) 18480

Dear Senator Lucas, Delegate Torian, and Director Maul:

Pursuant to Chapter 1289, Item C-55, of the 2020 Virginia Acts of Assembly, the Department of Corrections respectfully submits the required annual report on the use of the Department of Corrections Capital Infrastructure Fund (CIF). As specified, this report includes: (i) the facilities in which the funds were spent; (ii) a description of each project; and (iii) the total amount expended for each project.

In the 2024 Special Legislative Session, House Bill 6001 (HB6001) addressed several matters including the C-32 Improvements under the Department of Corrections Capital Infrastructure Fund (18480). For Fiscal Year 2025, The Department received an appropriation of \$7,669,280 that was assigned to provide air conditioning for the restrictive housing unit at Greensville Correctional Center. For Fiscal Year 2026, no additional funding was allocated to the Capital Infrastructure Fund.

Additionally, the Department has closed two previously active projects within the past fiscal year, which has resulted in a remaining balance of funds. A new project has been established using these available funds, as reflected on the attached spreadsheet for your review.
