SUBJECT: Virginia Military Survivors and Dependents Education Program – Stipend

The 2025 Virginia Acts of Assembly, Chapter 725, requires that the State Council of Higher Education receive reports of eligible students from public institutions of higher education for the Virginia Military Survivors and Dependent Education Program - Stipend. Specifically, Item 130.E. states as follows:

4. Each institution of higher education shall report the number of recipients for this program to the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia by April 1 of each year. The State Council of Higher Education for Virginia shall report this information to the Chairs of the House Appropriations and Senate Finance and Appropriations Committees by June 30 of each year.

By way of reminder, the enclosed table presents the use of the VMSDEP stipend and does not reflect usage of the VMSDEP tuition waiver, which carries both higher usage and higher costs. The VMSDEP stipend is available to students meeting the requirements under Tier 2 only. Tier 1 recipients are dependents of veterans whose disability occurred due to service-related injuries, while Tier 2 recipients are

dependents of veterans whose injuries occurred due to military operations against terrorism, on a peacekeeping mission, as a result of a terrorist act, or in any armed conflict.

In accordance with the stipend-reporting requirement, please find the attached report, which summarizes our findings to date. As of June 30, 2025, the records reflect a total of 6,153 recipients with \$10,054,563 combined in fall and spring term awards. The cost of the program is anticipated to increase after summer 2025 awards are reconciled. Summer awards are estimated to total approximately \$550,000. Please note that this report is preliminary. Final totals for the program will be established upon completion of the financial aid data submission process scheduled for later this fall.
