RE: Quarterly Report Pursuant to Va. Code § 19.2-163

Dear Governor Youngkin and Chairs Lucas and Torian:

Virginia Code § 19.2-163 requires the Executive Secretary to report to the Governor, members of the House Appropriations Committee and members of the Senate Finance and Appropriations Committee, on a quarterly basis, "the number and category of offenses charged involving adult and juvenile offenders in cases in which court-appointed counsel is assigned" and "the amounts paid by waiver above the initial cap to court-appointed counsel."

Effective January 1, 2025, Chapter 714 of the 2024 Virginia Acts of Assembly amended the compensation of court-appointed counsel specified in § 19.2-163 of the Code of Virginia. The following tables detail the vouchers submitted for compensation by court-appointed counsel during fiscal year 2025 and reflect the number and category of offenses charged involving adult and juvenile offenders. Please note that prior quarters are reflected in the expanded categorization of compensation, and payments of the new statutory fee caps and corresponding statutory waiver amounts are in effect in any cases concluded after January 1, 2025.

During fiscal year 2025, 6,572 requests for waivers of statutory fee caps were submitted seeking a total of \$4,686,313 and 6,416 requests for waivers were approved for a total of \$4,513,150 paid to court-appointed attorneys above the initial statutory fee cap.
