## Sales Highlights

July sales overall were up more than 11% compared to last year, from the continued strength of iLottery digital games. Retail sales were down just over 4%, with relatively low national jackpots and continued declines in the scratcher category of games. Draw game sales were flat compared to last year.

## **Profit Highlights**

July profits totaled \$64.4 million, down nearly 16% compared to last year. The profit decline is due almost exclusively to the good luck experienced by our daily draw games players. Pick 4 players won more than \$8 million on July 4, due to popular numbers drawn for the midday drawing and pushing our overall draw games prize expense rate to 63% for the month (typically we see this number closer to 50%) and we should expect future months to revert closer to that average. Retailers earned 5.7% in commissions and incentives, and the operating expense rate remains at a low 4.1%.

## Other Highlights

We look forward to welcoming our two newest members to the Virginia Lottery Board – Mr. Charles W. King and Ms. Rebecca J. Tres. We are also preparing for the upcoming revenue forecast process this fall.
