Senator and Delegates:

I am writing to report on the Virginia Investment Performance (VIP) and Major Eligible Employer (MEE) grants that were awarded during the first quarter of the 2025 calendar year as required by § 2.2-5103(D) of the <u>Code of Virginia</u>.

In the first quarter, ending March 31, 2025, two VIP grants were awarded. No MEE grants were awarded in the first quarter of 2025.

Virginia Investment Performance:

- 1. **Haleon**, located in the City of Richmond, is a manufacturer of pharmaceutical products. Awarded a \$950,000 grant, the company will be making a \$54.2 million investment by March 31, 2028. This project has been announced.
- 2. **Munters Corp.**, located in Botetourt County, is a manufacturer of refrigeration and cooling equipment. Awarded a \$500,000 grant, the company will be making a \$29.9 million investment and creating 270 new jobs by March 31, 2028. This project has been announced.

Major Eligible Employer:
