Dear Chairs Surovell, Lucas, Hope, and Torian:

Item 31, Paragraph D of the Appropriation Act, Chapter 2, 2024 Special Session I, requests that prior to January 1 of each year the Judicial Council and the Committee on District Courts submit a fiscal impact assessment of their recommendations for the creation of any new judgeships, including the cost of judicial retirement, to the Chairs of the House Committee on Court of Justice, Senate Judiciary Committee, House Appropriations Committee, and Senate Finance and Appropriations Committee.

Please find enclosed assessments of the annual cost of each authorized district court judgeship and each authorized circuit court judgeship. The Judicial Council continues to study the need for additional circuit court judgeships and does not recommend the authorization of any new circuit court judgeships at this time, but seeks to have existing authorized vacancies filled. The Committee on District Courts recommends the authorization two additional general district court judgeships, one each in the Ninth Judicial District and the Thirty-First Judicial District, and an additional juvenile and domestic relations district court judgeship in the Second Judicial District.
