During the first two quarters of fiscal year 2025, 4,011 requests for waivers of statutory fee caps were submitted seeking a total of \$ 2,741,289 and 3,917 requests for waivers were approved for a total of \$ 2,638,142 paid to court-appointed attorneys above the initial statutory fee cap.
