
Rockbridge County Public Schools -- Report for Chapter 566 Enactment Clause 1. (Regular Session, 2025)

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After a review of all of our school buildings, grounds, programs, and supports, Rockbridge County Public Schools (RCPS) has confirmed that our facilities meet all federal and state accessibility requirements, including the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, the 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design, and all relevant Virginia codes.

During this review, RCPS did not find any accessibility barriers that would prevent individuals with disabilities from fully participating in school activities. Our buildings and grounds are compliant, and our regular maintenance routines help us stay that way. Even so, we remain attentive to areas such as signage, walkways, entrances, and restrooms to ensure we continue to follow best practices in accessibility.

RCPS also reviewed access to programs and student supports. In keeping with IDEA and Section 504 requirements, all students with disabilities are able to participate in academic programs, extracurricular activities, and school-sponsored events. No programmatic access issues were identified.

Because no barriers were found during this review, we do not have any corrective projects planned at this time. However, we will continue to evaluate our facilities as part of our ongoing capital planning efforts and will address any needs that arise due to future renovations, expansions, or updates to state or federal requirements.

Rockbridge County Public Schools remains committed to maintaining accessible learning environments for all students, staff, and community members. We will continue to review our facilities and practices regularly to ensure full compliance and to support equitable access across the division.
