Dear Chairs Lucas, Torian, Favola and Rasoul:

In Item 139C.13 of the 2013 Appropriation Act, the Virginia General Assembly created a competitive school security equipment grant program for school divisions and regional programs. The Appropriation Act authorized \$6 million per year in grant funding through five-year equipment notes issued by the Virginia Public School Authority, with the debt service paid from the Literary Fund. \$12 million in funding was continued by the General Assembly for the 2025-2026 school year, the 13th year of the program. The Department of Education consolidates information from applying and awarded school divisions and submits an annual report to the Chairs of the Senate Finance and Appropriations and Education and Health Committees, as well as to the House Education and Appropriations Committees.

2025-2026 SCHOOL SECURITY EQUIPMENT GRANT PROGRAM

Legislation enacted by the 2013 General Assembly, HB 2343 and Item 139 C.13. of the 2013 Appropriation Act, created a school security equipment grant program for school divisions and regional programs. The legislation and appropriation act provision authorized \$6 million per year in funding for the school security equipment grants through five-year equipment notes issued by the Virginia Public School Authority, with the debt service paid from the Literary Fund. In subsequent years, program funding increased to \$12 million per year. \$12 million in funding was continued by the General Assembly for the 2025-2026 school year, the 13th year of the program.

The purpose of the Public School Security Equipment Grant Act of 2013 is to help school divisions purchase and install security equipment inside their school buildings, including non-structural building modifications for erecting security vestibules, security-related devices located outside of the school building on school property, and security-related devices installed inside school buses to improve and ensure the safety of students attending public schools in Virginia.

School divisions and regional programs apply annually for grants for their individual schools and facilities. School divisions must identify the security equipment for which grant funds are being requested from the approved list found in the application, as well as the estimated costs to purchase and install the security equipment. Applications are evaluated and funding awards are made based on competitive criteria developed by the Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) in collaboration with the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS).

2025-2026 Grant Requirements

Grants were awarded on a competitive basis using the following criteria:

- School divisions, including regional programs, were eligible to apply for and receive grant awards up to \$250,000.
- Applications had to be submitted to VDOE by August 1, 2025.
- Grant award notifications were issued on September 18, 2025.
- Grantees had to commit to purchasing the funded security equipment within six months of being notified of their grant award.
- Eligible schools had to be scheduled to remain open for at least five more years.
- No planned renovations/additions could be scheduled in the awarded school for the next five years, which would cause the security equipment being requested to become obsolete.
- A local match of 25 percent of the state grant amount is required. The Superintendent of Public Instruction is authorized to reduce the local match for school divisions with a composite index of less than 0.2000. The Virginia School for the Deaf and the Blind is exempt from the local match requirement.

2025-2026 Grant Competitive Ranking Criteria

- **Maximum of 10 points** allocated for new security equipment installed in schools with no existing video surveillance equipment.
- **Maximum of 5 points** allocated if a previous school security audit recommended the installation of the school security equipment requested in this application be installed in the school.
- **Maximum of 5 points** allocated for year the school was built.
- **Maximum of 15 points** allocated if this school has never received any grant funding from this program.
- **Maximum of 5 points** allocated if the school does not have an Uninterrupted Power Supply (UPS) to support security equipment.
- **Maximum of 20 points** allocated if the number of school-level incidents per 100 students for the following offense categories as reported in the is at or above certain percentiles for all schools statewide as reported in the Student Behavior and Administrative Response (SBAR) report: “weapons offenses,” “offenses against student, staff, and persons,” and “property offenses.”
 - 20 points allocated - at or above the 75th percentile.
 - 15 points allocated - at or above the 50th percentile but below the 75th percentile.
- **Maximum of 20 points** allocated for the Division Composite Index.
 - 20 points allocated - Division Composite Index of .0000 - .2999.
 - 15 points allocated - Division Composite Index of .3000 - .5999.
 - 10 points allocated - Division Composite Index of .6000 - .8000.
- **Maximum of 25 points** based upon the Institutional Poverty Level Report.
 - 15 points allocated if the school poverty level is 60% or greater.
 - 10 points allocated if the school poverty level is between 30% and 59%.
 - 5 points allocated if the school poverty level is less than 30%.
- **Maximum of 5 points** allocated if the school is an elementary school.

ADD IN OPTION: School Bus Safety Equipment (YES / NO)

- **Maximum of 10 points** awarded if any of the equipment listed above in the security related devices located on school buses section are to be installed in current or new school buses.
 - 10 points allocated if current bus fleet serving bus routes for the school has security equipment installed on 49% or less of the fleet.
 - 7 points allocated if current bus fleet serves bus routes for the school has security equipment installed on 50% to 74% of the fleet.

- 5 points allocated if current bus fleet serves bus routes for the school has security equipment installed on 75% or more of the fleet.

2025-2026 Grant Applications Received and Awarded

- 735 applications for funding were received totaling \$33,234,667.78 in school security equipment requests.
- Funds were awarded based on a rank ordering of applications' point total on the competitive application criteria.
- Grant were awarded to 433 schools in 99 school divisions totaling \$12.0 million.
