Executive Summary

At the direction of Virginia Code §23.1-102.1, this Annual Report on Executive Officers Salaries provides the salary by position of any executive officer of Christopher Newport that exceeded for the previous fiscal year the salary limit for the president of Christopher Newport. The report was submitted directly to the chairs of the House Committees on Appropriations and Education and the Senate Committees on Finance and Appropriations and Education and Health.

In FY2026, salaries for thirteen executive officers of Christopher Newport exceeded the appropriated salary of \$187,687 for the president in fiscal year 2026 as set forth in the Appropriation Act.
